

# Two-Way CONVERSION

## PROJECT ANNOUNCEMENT

### NOTICE OF CLOSURE

Beginning Monday, July 10, Sherman Street will be closed at the intersection of 20th Avenue until Monday, July 24, for storm line improvement and concrete paving. Traffic on Sherman Street will be detoured at 19th Avenue to Grant Street. One lane on 20th Avenue will remain open for west bound traffic.

### PROJECT OVERVIEW

Jalisco International, Inc., along with the City and County of Denver, will begin a two-way conversion project east of the central business district of Downtown Denver. The project will convert 19th and 20th Avenues, between Broadway and Park Avenue West, from one-way streets to two-way, bi-directional streets. The new two-way streets will also have integrated bicycle lanes. Grant and Logan

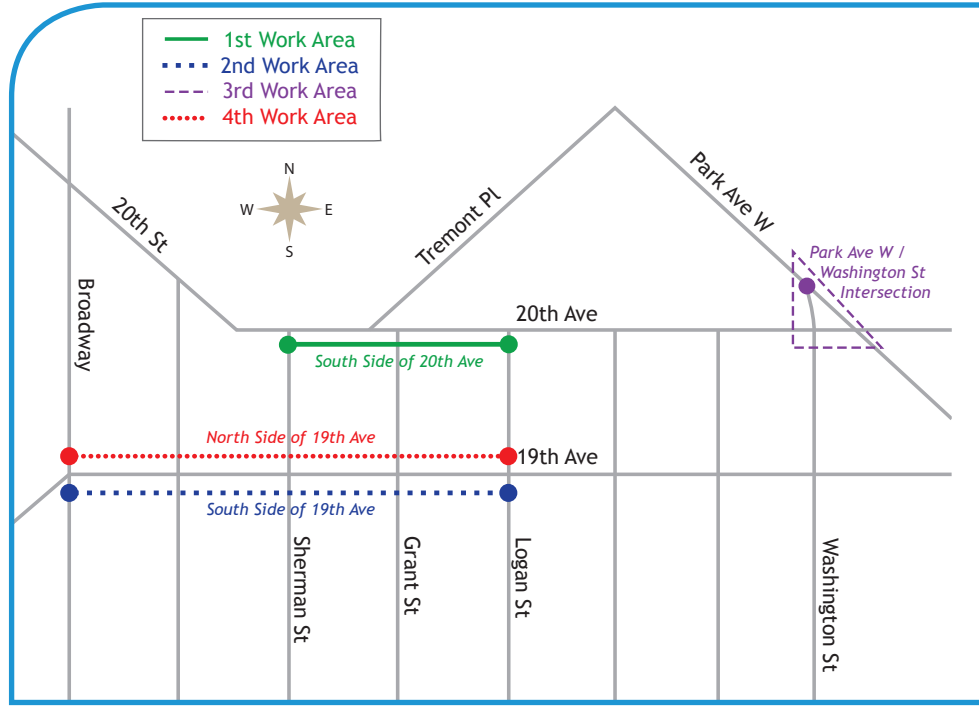


Streets, between 18th and 20th Avenues, will also be converted to a two-way vehicular operation.

This project will not only improve connectivity but will also increase safety through improved bicycle and pedestrian facilities, provide traffic calming in an increasingly residential area, and enhance neighborhood character with consistent street patterns.

A majority of the construction activity will take place at each intersection along 19th and 20th. Crews will need to remove the existing concrete curb ramps, install new storm water inlets, replace some of the storm water pipes under the concrete and rebuild the ADA (American with Disabilities Act) concrete ramps at the corners. Several of the intersections will also receive new traffic signals designed for a two-way traffic operation.

City and County of Denver Public Works awarded Jalisco International, Inc. this \$2.58 million bid for the project.



### SCHEDULE & WORK HOURS

The work will start on the south side of 20th Avenue near Logan Avenue:

- South Side of 20th Avenue, from Logan to Sherman—July through August
- South Side of 19th Avenue, from Broadway to Logan—August through September
- 20th Avenue/Washington Street/Park Avenue—Mid-September
- North Side of 19th Avenue, from Broadway to Logan—Mid-October

Working hours will be Monday through Friday 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. Occasional Saturday work may occur.

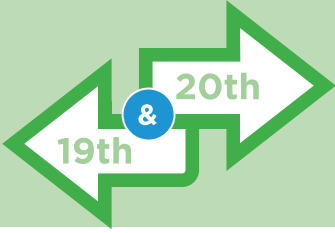


### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Along with the closure on Sherman Street, single lane closures on 20th Avenue should be expected. Travel speeds will be reduced as motorists merge to use the one through lane.

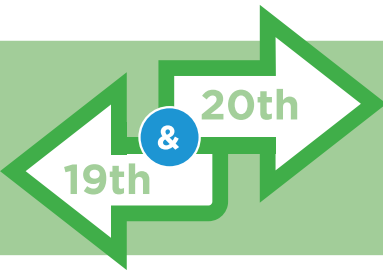

When construction activities move to 19th Avenue a full road closure may occur.



## PARKING IMPACTS

Street parking near active construction zones will be removed, 24-hours a day while crews are occupying the work area. The parking meters will be bagged and parking will not be allowed.



## SIDEWALK IMPACTS

Sections of the sidewalks in the construction zone will be closed, mostly near the street corners. Signed detours will be in place to guide pedestrians around the closed areas.

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained.
