- Use materials that will differentiate the street so it's safe and easy to use (like enhanced concrete) that is also maintenance friendly.





What is a Shared Street?

A shared street is a public space where pedestrians, bicyclists and motorists can travel together without the use of conventional street elements such as traffic lights, stop signs, curbs and pavement markings.

Benefits of a Shared Street?

- Provides a space for small, casual community activities.
- Improves safety for pedestrians and bicyclists through designs that reduces speeds for motorists.
- Builds a positive space for additional public seating, artwork and landscaping.
- Allows ongoing access for deliveries to businesses during off hours.
