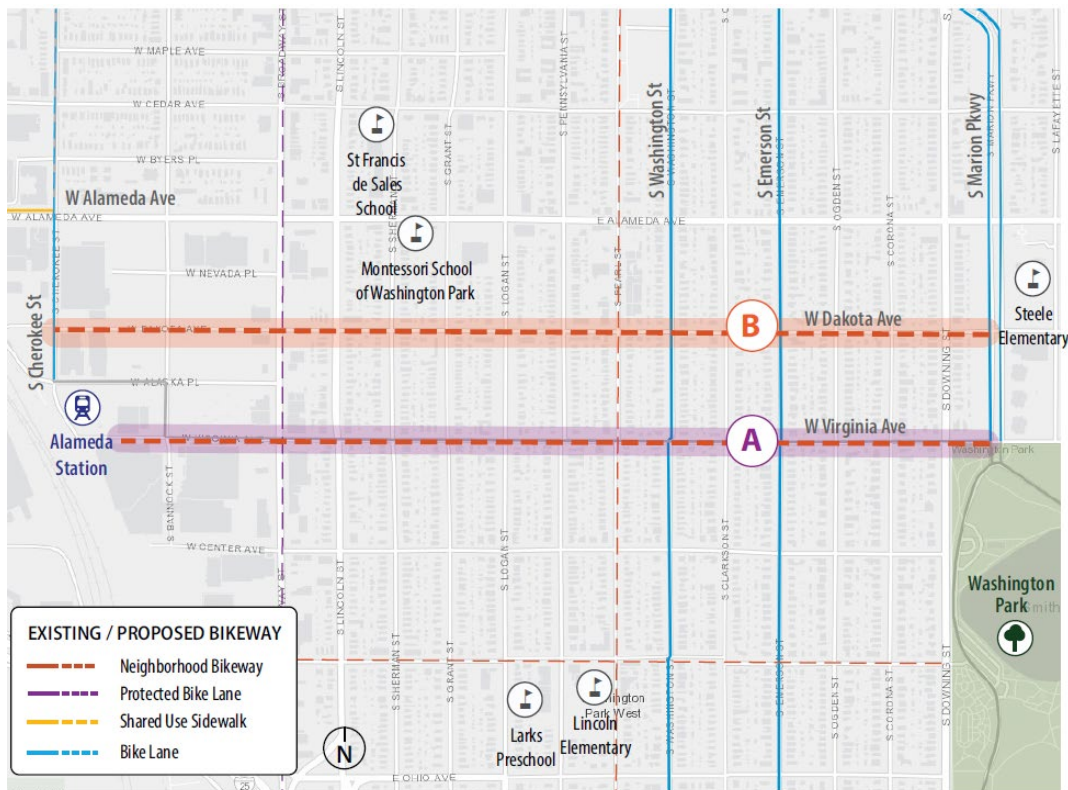


## South Central Community Transportation Network Survey Summary: E Virginia Ave and E Dakota Ave

Denver Moves: Bicycles included the recommendation to install a neighborhood bikeway along E Virginia Ave, connecting N Broadway to Washington Park.

The project team collected community feedback through an online survey to determine whether the project should move the E Virginia Ave alignment forward or consider establishing a neighborhood bikeway on E Dakota Ave instead. The survey garnered a total of 179 responses from April 27, 2020 through May 17, 2020.



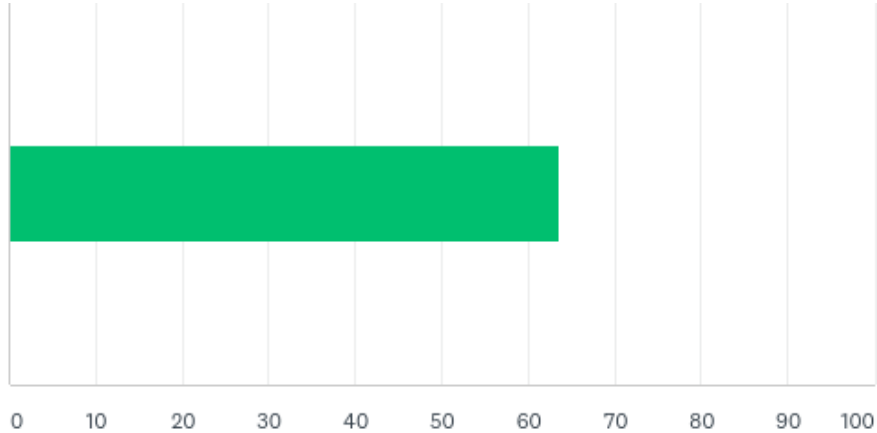
Based on the survey results, community feedback regarding priorities for the proposed improvements, and technical analysis regarding the feasibility of alternative options in the near-term, **the city is moving forward with an option that prioritizes a neighborhood bikeway along Dakota Ave and routes to Virginia Ave to cross Lincoln and Broadway using the existing traffic signals.** Dedicated bikeways will be provided for the section of the route that travels along Virginia.

This is the most feasible near-term option, as the city does not currently have funding available to construct new signals along Dakota Ave at Lincoln and Broadway. While the city is advancing the Dakota/Virginia alignment, we will continue to seek resources to construct traffic signals along Dakota Ave in the future.

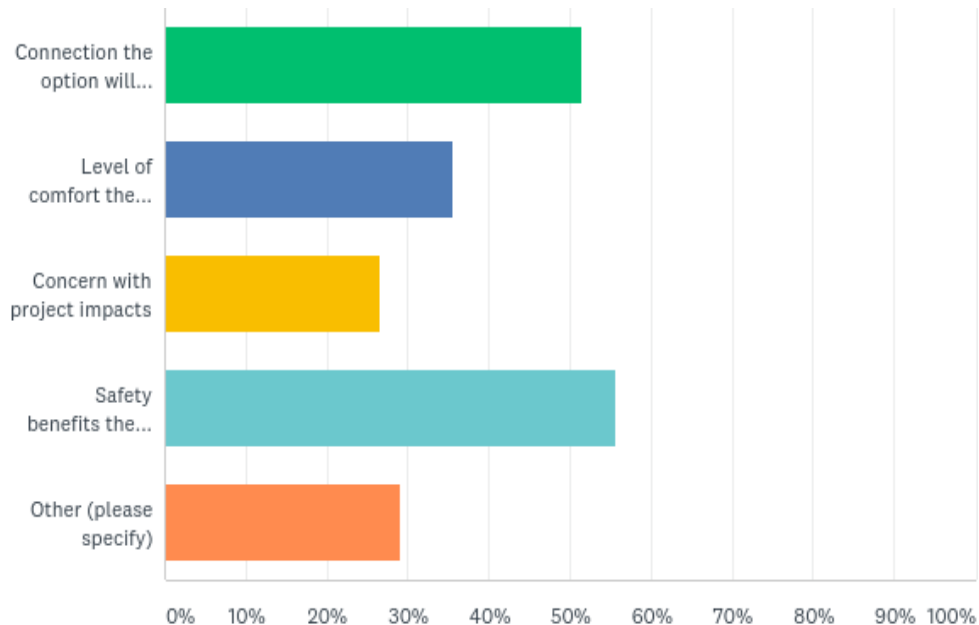

## Q2: Of the factors below, what influenced your level of interest? (Check all that apply)

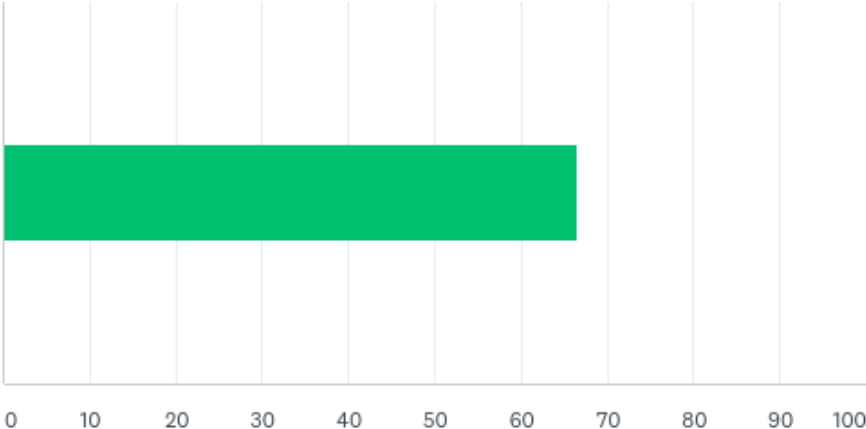

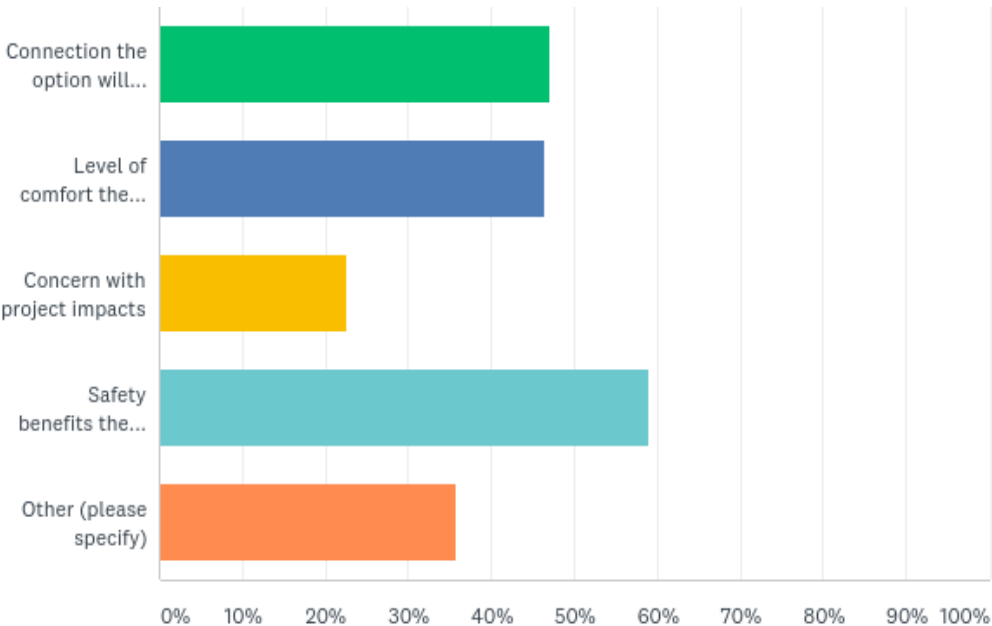

# Q4: Of the factors below, what influenced your level of interest? (Check all that apply)

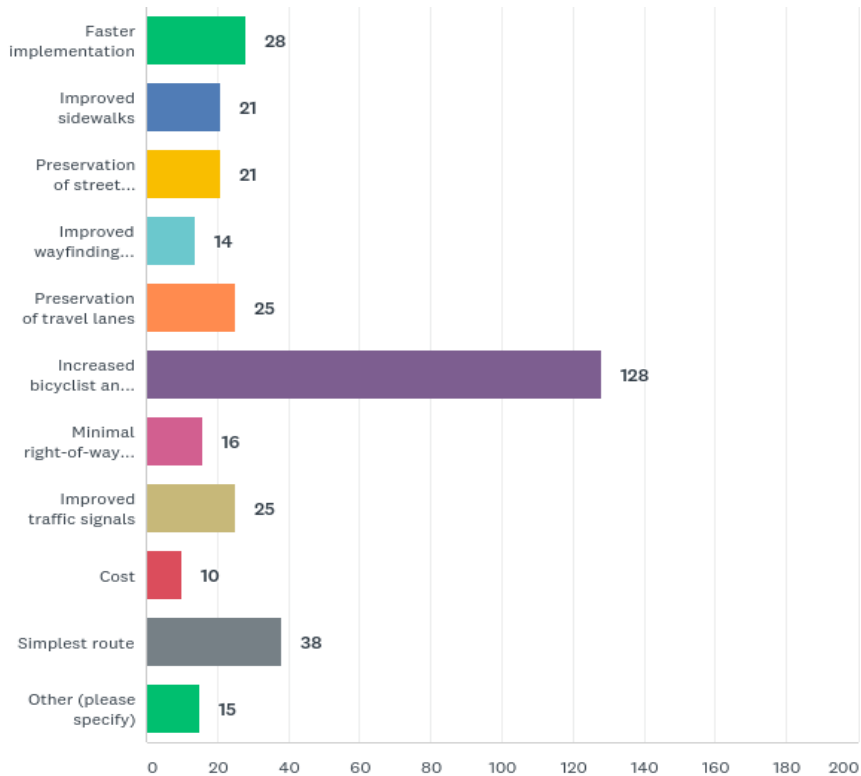
