**Fee Structure:** Payment for your license is due when you submit your application to the Department of Excise and Licenses. Licenses may be purchased with cash, check or credit card. You can calculate your total license fee based on the number of vehicles your company owns. The company fee structure is outlined below.

- 1-2 vehicles - \$100
- 3-9 vehicles - \$300
- 10-20 vehicles - \$600
- 21 and more vehicles - \$1,200

**New hauler license applicants must also pay a \$25 application fee in addition to their license fee.**
