**Synopsis: On the evening of September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2000 members of the Denver Police Department responded to the area of East 29th Avenue and Adams Street on a report of a shooting. Upon arrival, officers located the victim, subsequently identified as Alonzo Witherspoon, within his vehicle. Mr. Witherspoon was shot and died at the scene. Prior to his murder, Mr. Witherspoon was a Deacon at the Mt. Carmel Missionary Baptist Church and served in the United States military.**

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
