**Synopsis: On the morning of October 13, 2001 victim Jeremy Martinez was a passenger in a vehicle that was driving eastbound on Interstate-70. Near the Pecos Street exit, an unknown suspect in a second vehicle fired into the vehicle that the victim occupied, striking the victim. The suspect vehicle immediately fled from the scene. The victim was transported to a local hospital, but unfortunately died the following day. The suspect(s) responsible for the murder of Jeremy Martinez have yet to be identified.**

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
