Synopsis: On July 24th, 2004 the victim was involved in a fight with an unknown suspect. During the course of the physical confrontation, the victim was stabbed. The victim was transported to a local hospital and after his condition was stabilized, he was discharged one week later. Then on the morning of August 5th, 2004 the victim died as a result of medical complications subsequent to the stab wounds he sustained during the fight.
