Upon arrival, officers located the victim, subsequently identified as Anastacio Desantos Rodriguez. He was pronounced deceased at the scene. During the course of the follow-up investigation, it was determined that Anastacio Desantos Rodriguez died as a result of sustaining blunt force trauma injuries. The suspect(s) responsible for the murder of Mr. Rodriguez have yet to be identified.**
