Synopsis: On 9/13/2008, the victim observed a suspicious male outside his home and went to investigate. While outside, it is unknown what happened to the victim. The victim's wife discovered the victim lying in the alley suffering from a head injury. Paramedics transported the victim to a local hospital for treatment. On September 2, 2010, the victim died as a result of a traumatic brain injury. The Coroner signed the autopsy report as manner of death Homicide.
