## Synopsis:

On February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2016 at approximately 10:30 p.m. DPD officers responded to the area of 2011 W. Gill Place on a report of shots fired. Upon arrival the victim, David Castillo was found suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. He was transported to a nearby hospital where he later died from his injuries.
