**Synopsis: On the evening of September 20<sup>th</sup>, 1971 Rebecca Hernandez and her young child were walking home after shopping at a neighborhood grocery store. Rebecca Hernandez was confronted by a pair of unknown suspects and ordered to relinquish her personal belongings. During the commission of this street robbery, one of the suspects knocked the grocery bag out of Rebecca Hernandez's hands and shot her. After Rebecca Hernandez fell to the ground, mortally wounded, the suspects took the victim's wallet and fled the scene. The suspects responsible for this senseless murder have yet to be identified.**
