### Synopsis:

Members of the Denver Police Department responded to the apartment complex located at 1660 Gaylord Street to provide assistance to paramedics that were on scene investigating a reported DOA. Upon arrival, officers determined that the victim, subsequently identified as thirty-two-year-old Stannard "Pete" Chappelle, was shot to death.
