Synopsis: Zdenka Kalendovskiy was a physician at the medical clinic located near the intersection of East Colfax Avenue and Washington Street. After Dr. Kalendovskiy finished work, she walked across the clinic’s parking lot to her vehicle. It was at this point that an unknown suspect confronted Dr. Kalendovskiy near her vehicle. The suspect produced a firearm, shot Dr. Kalendovskiy, and then immediately fled the area. Dr. Kalendovskiy was transported to a local hospital, but unfortunately died as a result of her injuries.
