


**“We Will Never Forget”**

**Synopsis: On the morning of August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 1977 members of the Denver Police Department were alerted to a body found within the parking lot near the intersection of W. 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Acoma Street. During the course of the follow-up investigation it was determined that victim, subsequently identified as Edward Sheridan, was stabbed to death by an unknown assailant(s) during a street robbery. Mr. Sheridan was known to frequent a local liquor store that was near the location he was murdered.**

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
