Synopsis: On the evening of November 14th, 1980 Mr. Robert Jackson was at the Vickers gas station getting fuel for his vehicle. During this time, Mr. Jackson became involved in an argument with an unknown male. The unknown male retrieved a handgun from his vehicle and shot Mr. Jackson. The suspect then fled the area in his vehicle. Mr. Jackson was rushed to a local hospital, but unfortunately died as a result of his injuries four days later on November 18th, 1980.

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
