**Synopsis: On the morning of December 14, 1980 members of the Denver Police Department were alerted to body floating in the draining ditch near the Pepsi-Cola Company, which is located near the intersection of 38<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Arkins Court. The body was later identified to be that of 18 year old Julie Marchese. As part of the criminal investigation it was determined that Julie Marchese was the victim of a homicide.**
