


**“We Will Never Forget”**

**Synopsis: On August 17<sup>th</sup>, 1987 members of the Denver Police Department responded to the area of West 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Lipan Street on a report of disturbance. During the on-scene investigation, it was discovered that two individuals were injured. Victim Daniel Archuletta sustained the most serious injury and was transported to a local hospital for treatment. A few weeks later, Daniel Archuletta unfortunately died as a result of the gunshot wound he suffered during the neighborhood disturbance. The suspect(s) responsible for the death of Daniel Archuletta have yet to be identified.**

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
