Synopsis: Friday morning, Margaret was found murdered in a grassy area of a vacant lot in an alley between Welton and Glenarm Streets near Lawson Park. She was strangled to death. The night before her murder, Margaret was reported to have been at a neighborhood establishment called the Denver Grill, which was in close proximity to the murder scene.

Margaret lived in Denver’s Swansea Neighborhood and frequently took the bus. Margaret leaves behind six children. Her friends and family remember her as an avid seamstress, who would make various outfits for her children. She is also remembered for her beautiful flower gardens. As a result of Margaret’s untimely death, she was unable to meet with one of her daughters that Saturday to help her plant flowers in her garden.
