Synopsis: Carlos was at his west Denver home near the intersection of W. 13th Avenue and Tennyson Street. Across the street from Carlos' residence, a house party had become increasingly unruly. As a result of the loud noise in this normally quiet neighborhood, Carlos hollered for the occupants within the house to turn the music down. Shortly thereafter, some individuals from the party drove by Carlos and exchanged words with him. These same individuals then drove by a second time and shot Carlos to death from inside their car.
