


“We Will Never Forget”

Synopsis: Shortly before midnight on August 31st 1995, Louis Mitchell was near Lawson Park when he went to speak to an occupant of a vehicle that was also in the area of the park. During this time, Louis Mitchell was shot by an unknown suspect. Medical and police personnel were dispatched to the scene and Louis Mitchell was immediately transported to a local hospital. Unfortunately, Louis Mitchell did not survive and died a few hours later from the gunshot wound he sustained. The suspect(s) responsible for the murder of Mr. Mitchell have yet to be identified.

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
