Synopsis: On the afternoon of January 25, 1997, members of the Denver Police Department were summoned to the location of 57 S. Jasmine St. by relatives of Surle Goldfogle. The victim, Mrs. Goldfogle, was found inside her home and had died as a result of being beaten to death by an apparent intruder. Prior to her murder, Mrs. Goldfogle had just returned from shopping at the King Soopers store located near Leetsdale and Monaco Blvd. To this day, this tragedy continues to sadden Mrs. Goldfogle’s family, her friends and the residents of the Crestmoor neighborhood.

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
