Synopsis: The victim and her companion were walking in a residential neighborhood when they noticed a vehicle approaching. The victim's companion was able to avoid being hit by the vehicle; however the victim was struck and dragged under the vehicle. The victim was immediately transported to a local hospital, but unfortunately did not survive.
