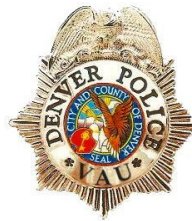

Synopsis: On January 31, 1999, Troy was seen wrestling with an unknown person on the steps of the downtown Denver RTD bus turn-around center located near Colfax and Broadway. Troy’s body was later found on the steps of the nearby Denver Post Building. He had been stabbed to death. Troy had worked as a bus driver, highway worker and air conditioner repairman. Troy would either walk or use the bus as his primary means of transportation. Troy frequently had extra clothes in his possession and would provide the garments to the homeless community.

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
