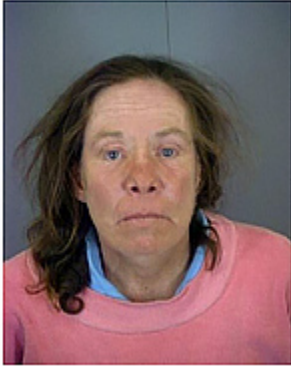




“We Will Never Forget”

Synopsis: Members of the Denver Police Department responded to a call of an unresponsive female found within Sunken Gardens Park. The victim, subsequently identified as Maureen Maningas, was pronounced deceased at the scene. During the course of the preliminary investigation, it was discovered that the victim sustained significant blunt force trauma. The suspect(s) responsible for the death of Maureen Maningas have yet to be identified.
