


“We Will Never Forget”

Synopsis: On the late evening of November 5th, 2008 Denver Police Officers responded to the area of East 7th Avenue and Elm Street on a report of a shooting and two men down. Upon arrival, the officers located two victims. Irvin Herrera-Gonzales was pronounced dead at the scene. The second victim, Agustin Puente-Yanez was taken to Denver Health Medical Center but unfortunately died the following day as a result of the gun shot wounds he sustained.

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
