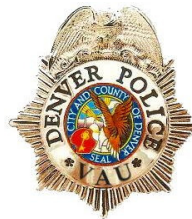

**Synopsis: Bruce Harrell and his friend had just left a local night spot called Club Beyond and were stopped at a traffic light located near Downing and Welton Streets. At this time, two vehicles pulled up next to the vehicle Bruce was driving. One of the occupants within the suspect vehicle got out and began to fire into Bruce’s vehicle. Both Bruce and his friend were struck by the gun fire. Bruce attempted to drive to safety but collided with multiple vehicles before coming to a stop. Bruce and his friend were immediately taken to the hospital. Unfortunately, Bruce died as a result of his injuries.**
