


“We Will Never Forget”

Synopsis: On August 9th, 2007 at around 10:50 p.m., officers responded on a call of a shooting at East Colfax Avenue and Gaylord Street, the Popeye’s Chicken Restaurant. Witnesses observed two males talking in the parking lot next to the drive-through. During this conversation, one of the males produced a handgun and shot the victim, Charles Jackson, several times. The suspect then fled the scene in a vehicle. When officers arrived they found Charles lying next to the drive-through suffering from gunshot wounds. The victim was transported to the hospital where he later died as a result of his injuries.

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
