


“We Will Never Forget”

Synopsis: Gilbert Garcia was killed in a drive-by shooting occurring in the 1800 block of E 34th Avenue on 2/8/07 at about 2100 hrs. The victim was pronounced dead at the scene. He had recently enrolled in Adams State College and was home for the weekend to visit his mother. He and two other males were driving in Gilbert’s pick-up truck to a friend’s house. A vehicle followed them for a bit and then turned off. Another car pulled next to the victim’s vehicle, and someone fired into the victim’s vehicle. The victim was struck by the bullet and died.

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
