Synopsis: On July 3rd, 2007, officers responded to the Frederick Douglass Park, on East 30th Avenue and Franklin Street, for a report of a shooting. Officers found the victim, Gustavo Arambula-Castaneda, on the grass on the east side of the intersection. He was shot to death in a drive-by-shooting. He was transported to the hospital and later died as a result of gun shot wounds.

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
