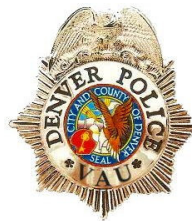

Synopsis: On June 4th, 2006, at approximately 2:00 a.m., the victim, James Wyatt Jr. was outside a club in the lower downtown area. Witnesses stated that James became involved in a verbal argument with an unknown group of men in a vehicle. As the victim approached the vehicle, one of the occupants fired a shot and hit the victim in the chest. The vehicle then fled from the scene. James Wyatt was taken to the hospital, where he later died as a result of his injuries.
