Synopsis: On October 24, 2008, at approximately 11:05 p.m., officers responded to the 800 block of 31st street on the report of a shooting. Upon arrival, officers found the victim, Jimmia Reed, suffering from an apparent gun shot wound to the neck. She was struck when an unknown party fired into the crowd. Paramedics transported the Jimmia to Denver Health Medical Center, where she died as a result of her injuries.

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
