


“We Will Never Forget”

Synopsis: On July 2nd, 2006, officers responded to W. 1st Avenue at Osceola Street on a report of a shooting. Jorge and friends had just left McDonald’s when they noticed they were being chased by an SUV. Jorge was the passenger in the vehicle that was shot at by a group of unknown(s) from inside the SUV. The victim was struck by the gunfire and transported to the hospital where he died as a result of his injuries.
