


“We Will Never Forget”

Synopsis: The victim, Jose Hernandez-Galaviz, was last seen by his family on Sunday, March 25, 2007. On March 26th, 2007, at approximately 4 a.m., the victim was seen in the company of an unknown female, parked in the area of 33rd Street and Lawrence Avenue. A short time later the victim and his vehicle were reported as “missing” to the Denver Police Department. On March 31st, 2007, Mr. Hernandez-Galaviz was found dead inside of the car. He had been shot several times. Mr. Hernandez-Galaviz was of Mexican decent and did not speak English.

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
