


“We Will Never Forget”

Synopsis: On October 29th, 2006, officers were called to 5601 W. Green Meadows Drive on a report of a shooting. Upon arrival, the victim, Nicholas Magers, was located suffering from a gunshot wound. Nicholas was transported to the hospital, where he died as a result of his injuries. The investigation found that a male got out of a car, fire several shots, then got back in his car and the vehicle fled the scene.

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
