


“We Will Never Forget”

Synopsis: Otis Brown Jr. was last seen by a co-worker at 8:30 p.m. on November 30th 2007. They went to a bar after work. Otis left for home early because he had to work early the next morning. On December 1st, 2007, officers received a call on a suspicious vehicle in the 3900 block of Jackson Street. Upon arrival, the officers located the victim shot to death in his car.
