Synopsis: On May 18th, 2006, officers responded to 11200 E. Dartmouth Avenue on a report of a shooting. The victim, Phillippe Toliver, was in the parking lot of this location with a friend to meet with some people. Upon arrival, officers found Phillippe dead in the front passenger seat of a vehicle with a gunshot wound to the head. The victim’s friend was suffering from several gunshot wounds and was taken to hospital.

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
