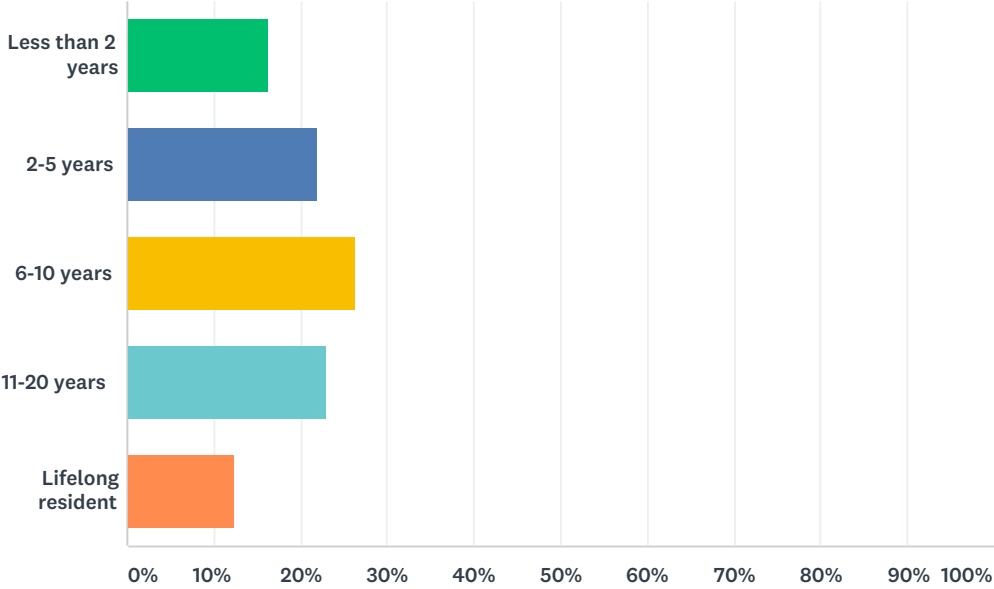

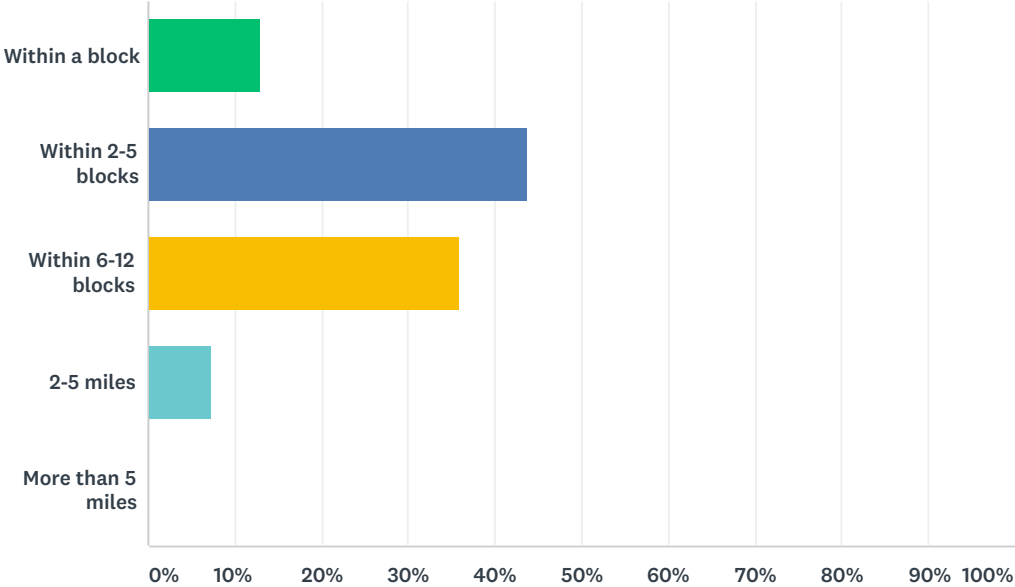

Q2 How far is the park from your home?

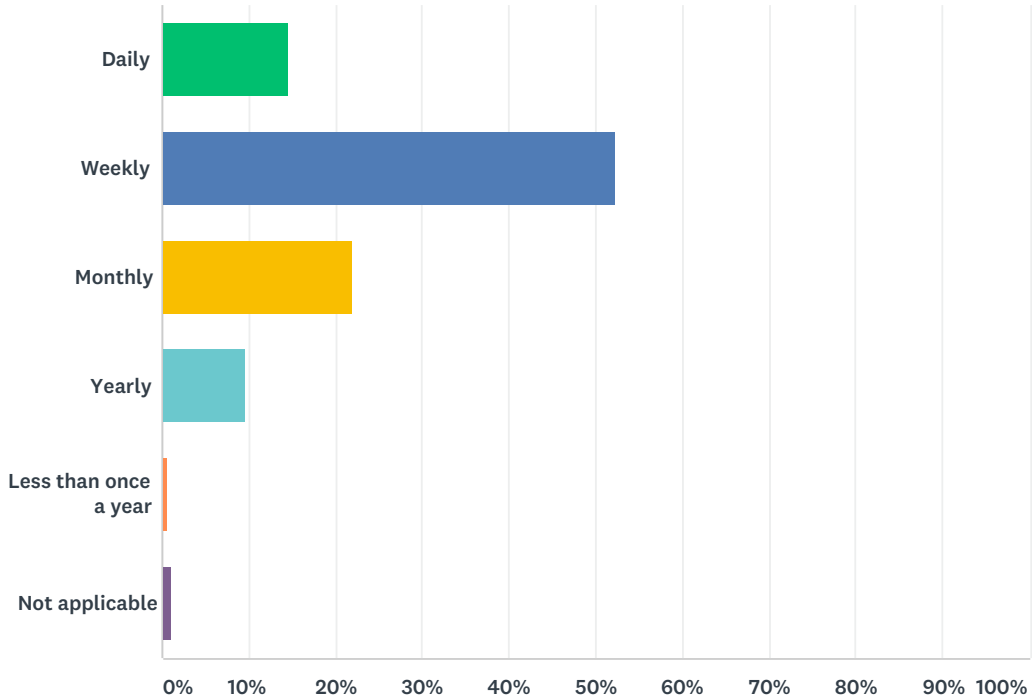

Q3 How often do you (or someone in your household) typically visit this park and/or playground?

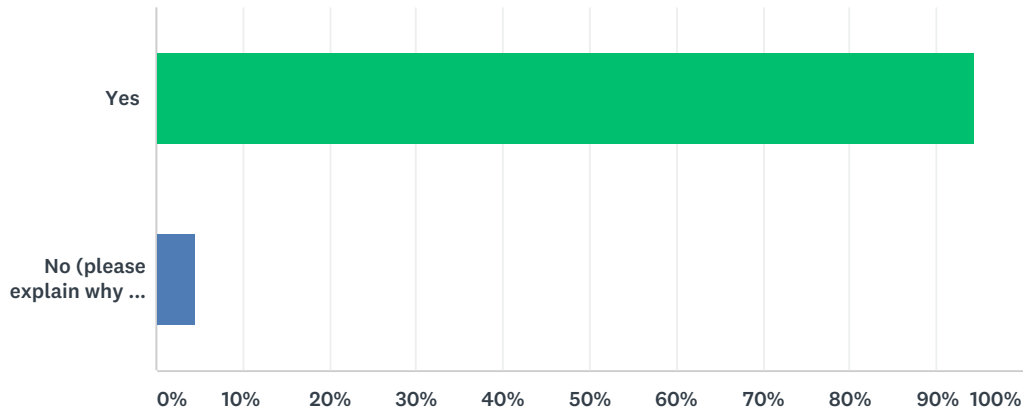

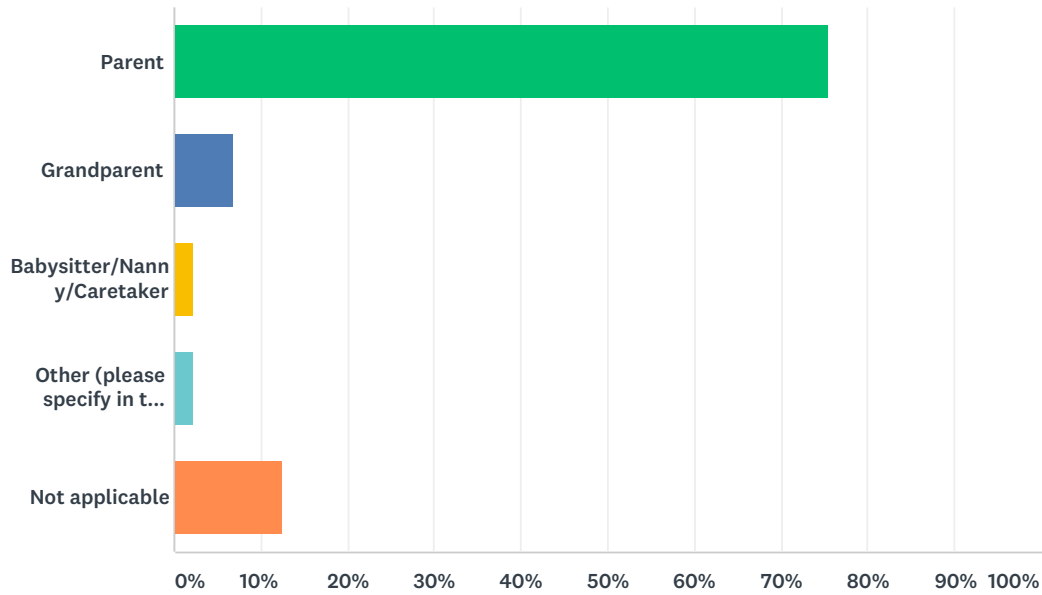

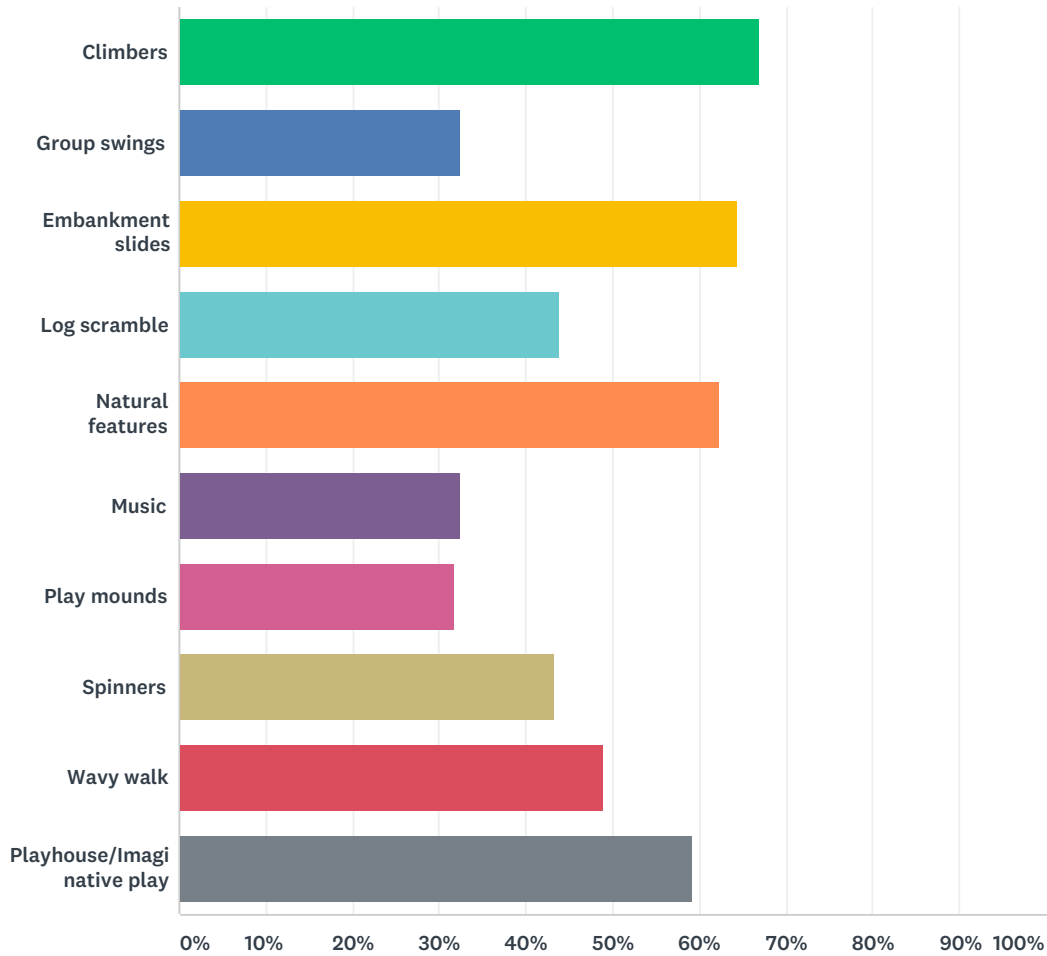
