Fentanyl is a powerful synthetic opioid that is up to 50 times more potent than heroin and 100 times more potent than morphine.

OVERDOSES HAPPEN FASTER and are harder to stop.

- It comes in pills, pure powders, and powder mixed with other drugs.
- It cannot be seen, tasted, or smelled when mixed into other drugs.

FIVE WAYS TO REDUCE OVERDOSE RISK:

1 CARRY NALOXONE AND/OR MAKE SURE THOSE AROUND YOU CARRY NALOXONE (PURCHASE NALOXONE AT WWW.STOPTHECLOCKCOLORADO.ORG)

2 DON'T USE ALONE: IF YOU DO, LET SOMEONE KNOW SO THEY CAN CHECK ON YOU

3 AVOID MIXING DRUGS: DON'T MIX OPIOIDS WITH ALCOHOL OR BENZODIAZEPINES

4 TEST A SMALL AMOUNT BEFORE USING

5 IF INJECTING, INJECT SLOWER
