Issue committees. Once the issue committee is formed, it must report monthly until the election. The committee must also file Major Contributor, Post-Election, and Year-End reports. See *D.R.M.C. § 15-35(c)*.

Please Note:

Reports must be filed no later than 11:59 p.m. MT on the due date to be considered a timely submission. See *D.R.M.C. § 15-36(b)*.

- * If a reporting day falls on a weekend, legal holiday, or a City and County of Denver furlough day, the report shall be filed by the next business day. If a reporting day falls on a day when the city is fully or partially closed for business, then the report shall be filed in accordance with any and all rules or policies designated by the clerk and recorder. See *D.R.M.C. § 15-35(i)*.
 - This provision does not apply to Major Contributor, Independent Expenditure, and Electioneering Communication Reports. See *D.R.M.C. §§ 15-35(f) and 15-35.5(a)*.
