



NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF ELECTION RULES

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Article VI of Chapter 2 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code (D.R.M.C.), that the Denver Clerk and Recorder, has adopted new election rules, after allowing for public written comment and testimony at the public rulemaking hearing conducted on July 2, 2019. These new rules concern the administration and enforcement of municipal campaign finance laws and increasing transparency in procedures to campaign finance requirements. Specifically, the rules include revisions necessary to: establish uniformity and ensure proper administration of changes adopted in the campaign finance laws by registered and qualified voters of the City and County of Denver in 2018; clarify and update definitions, clarify the language of existing provisions in rules and the Denver Revised Municipal Code concerning the creation of a dedicated fund to match campaign donations of up to \$50 per donor to candidates who participate in a matching fund program with lower donation limits.

These rules and regulations are adopted under the authority of § 8.1.2 (E) of the Denver Charter and in accordance with Article VI of Chapter 2 of the D.R.M.C.
