**Proposed modifications to campaign finance rules.**

### **Purpose and Subject:**

The Clerk and Recorder will conduct a public hearing on proposed amendments to campaign finance rules under the authority of Section 8.1.2(E) of the Charter of the City and County of Denver and Section 15-46 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code (D.R.M.C.). Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Article VI of Chapter 2, D.R.M.C., that the Denver Clerk and Recorder is considering amendments to Denver's campaign finance rules for the purpose of improving the administration and enforcement of municipal campaign finance laws and increasing transparency in procedures to campaign finance requirements. Specifically, the proposed amendments include revisions necessary to: establish uniformity and ensure proper administration of changes adopted in the campaign finance laws by registered and qualified voters of the City and County of Denver in 2018; clarify and update definitions, clarify the language of existing provisions in rules and the Denver Revised Municipal Code concerning the creation of a dedicated fund to match campaign donations of up to \$50 per donor to candidates who participate in a matching fund program with lower donation limits.

This is a preliminary draft of the proposed rules that may be revised before the July 2, 2019, rulemaking hearing. If changes are made, a revised copy of the proposed rules will be available

to the public and a copy will be posted on the Denver Elections Division website no later than June 25, 2019.

This hearing is open and the public is encouraged to attend. Public testimony will be taken at the hearing.
