**NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF EMERGENCY ELECTION RULE  
CONCERNING DESIGNATION OF VOTER SERVICE AND POLLING CENTERS  
FOR THE MAY 5, 2015 MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION AND THE JUNE 2, 2015,  
MUNICIPAL RUN-OFF ELECTION**

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Article VI of Chapter 2 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code (D.R.M.C.), that the Denver Clerk and Recorder has adopted Emergency Rule No. 13 (the “Emergency Rule”) concerning the designation of voter service and polling centers for the May 5, 2015 Municipal General Election and the June 2, 2015, Municipal Run-Off Election as an necessary measure in order to immediately protect and promote the uniformity and consistency of designated polling locations. The Emergency Rule shall continue in effect for no more than one hundred eighty (180) days after the date of adoption.

The Emergency Rule is adopted under the authority of § 8.1.2 (E) of the Denver Charter.
