The City and County of Denver, in collaboration with Regional Transportation District and Downtown Denver Partnership are now embarking on Denver Moves: Downtown, a planning effort that is re-envisioning the city's downtown transportation system.

It's more than just a transportation plan — it's a critical step in building a successful and flexible multi-modal future for Denver.

The project kicked off in Fall 2018 and is expected to be complete by early 2020.

It will build off years of study and analysis to create a road-map that will prioritize near-term improvements while identifying a long-term vision for the future of mobility downtown. Given the hundreds of thousands of people that visit, live, work and play in downtown Denver each year it's critical to develop a vision that reflects our desired future of mobility in the city's center.
