OVERVIEW**

Elevate Denver is the city's 10-year general obligation bond program approved by voters in 2017. This program is critical to preserving and improving the things that define Denver and enhancing safety, mobility and quality of life across the city – both now and into the future.

Improvement projects will be constructed across Denver over the next decade, providing long-term benefits to residents and visitors in the following areas:

TRANSPORTATION & MOBILITY Upgrading streets, bridges, sidewalks, transit and our bike network

CULTURAL FACILITIES Repairing museums, theaters, the zoo, botanic gardens and other key cultural attractions in Denver

DENVER HEALTH Constructing a new Outpatient Medical Center to expand Denver Health's capacity by up to 50 percent

PARKS & RECREATION Rejuvenating recreation centers, modernizing parks and updating irrigation systems

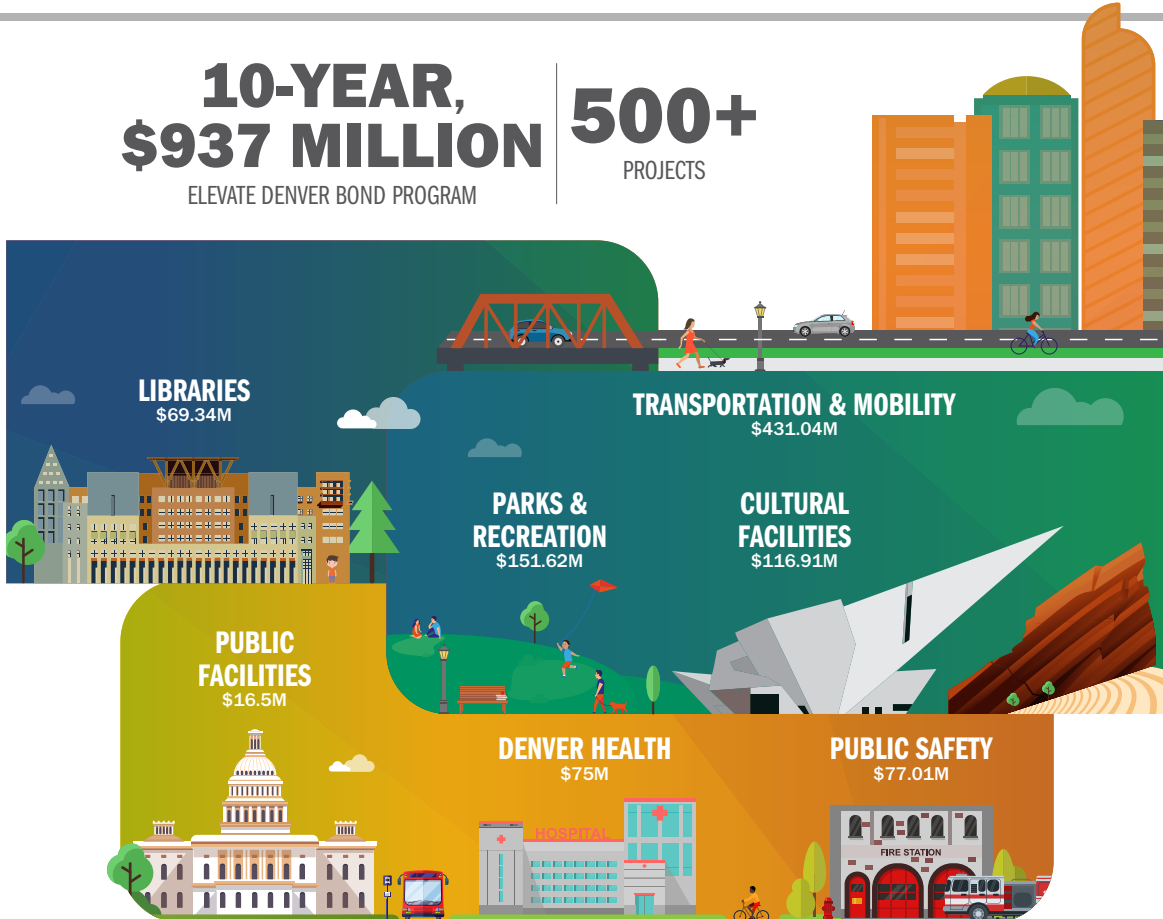
LIBRARIES Improving the Denver Central Library along with 10 other branches

PUBLIC SAFETY Replacing two police stations and renovating kitchens and restrooms in half of the city's fire stations to ensure better gender equity

PUBLIC FACILITIES Upgrading public buildings to be ADA-compliant and completing other necessary maintenance to city facilities
