

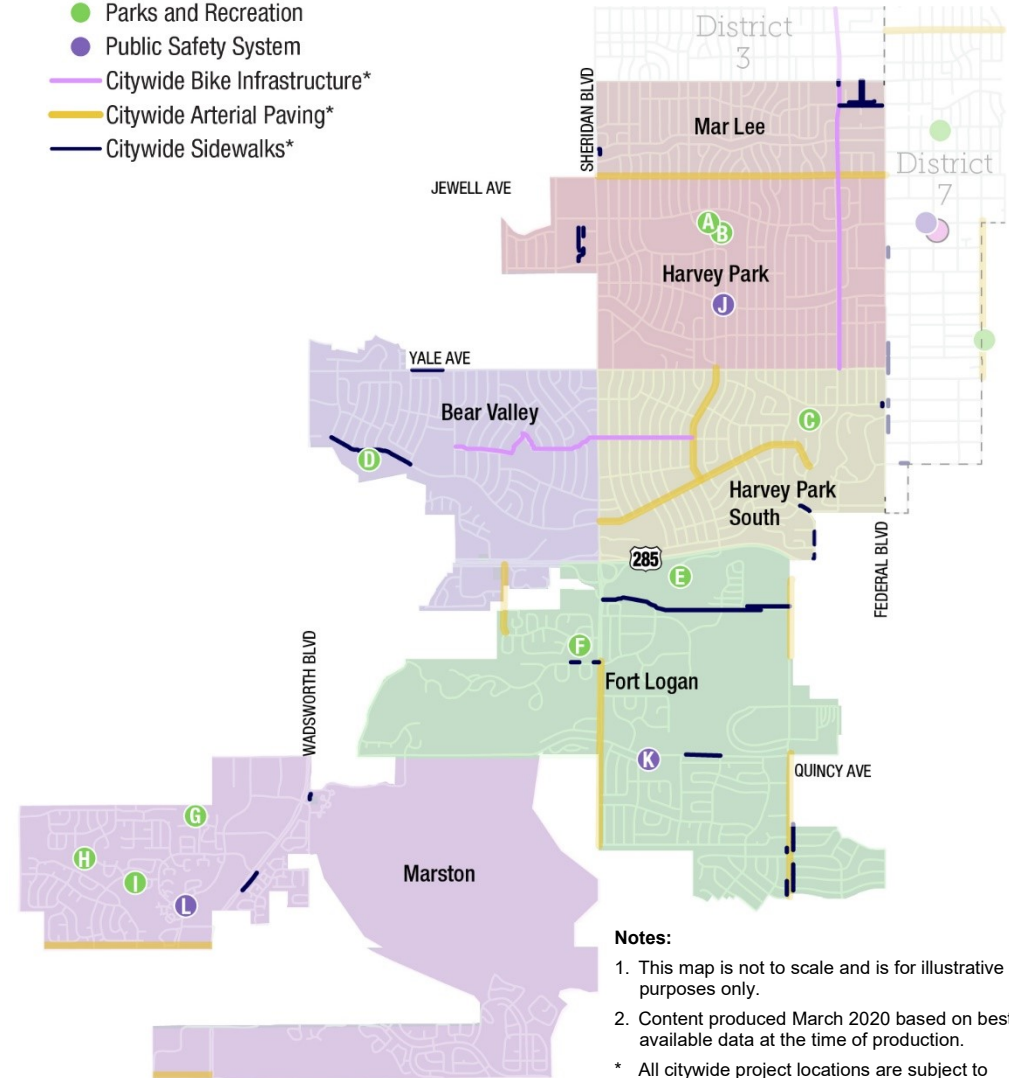

Current Status	Project Name and Description
<b>A</b> Design	<b>Harvey Park Irrigation:</b> Upgrade water supply and replace old irrigation systems with more efficient equipment
<b>B</b> Design	<b>Harvey Neighborhood Park and Recreation Center:</b> Address deferred maintenance and construct new off-street parking
<b>C</b> Development	<b>Loretto Heights Neighborhood Park:</b> Replace aging playground equipment
<b>D</b> Construction	<b>Bear Valley Park:</b> Replace six tennis courts with post tensioned concrete and add new high efficiency lighting
<b>E</b> Development	<b>Bear Creek Neighborhood Park:</b> Replace picnic areas
<b>F</b> Design	<b>Pinecrest Neighborhood Park:</b> Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete
<b>G</b> Development	<b>Stanford and Balsam Neighborhood Park:</b> Replace aging playground equipment
<b>H</b> Development	<b>Wagon Trail Neighborhood Park:</b> Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete
<b>I</b> Development	<b>Southwest Recreation Center:</b> Address deferred maintenance
<b>J</b> Development	<b>Fire Station 25:</b> Address deferred maintenance
<b>K</b> Construction	<b>Fire Station 28:</b> Update living area
<b>L</b> Design	<b>Fire Station 30:</b> Address deferred maintenance
