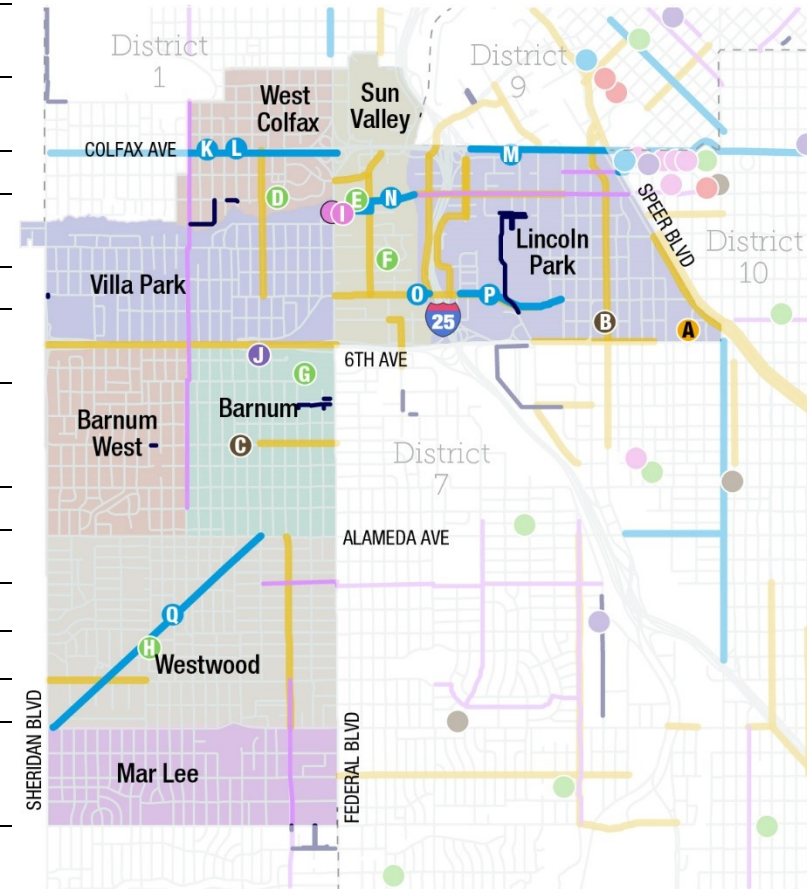


ELEVATE DENVER BOND PROGRAM COUNCIL DISTRICT 3 PROJECTS



Current Status	Project Name and Description
A Construction	Denver Health: Construction of an Ambulatory Care Center to be the core of the DHHA campus
B Construction	Byers Library: Refurbish architectural features, replace outdated equipment, and renovate space
C Development	Ross Barnum Library: Replace outdated equipment and renovate space
D Construction	Paco Sanchez Re-Imagine Play Project (Phase 2): Construct an innovative new play area, including outdoor venue and plaza
E Development	Rude Recreation Center: Address deferred maintenance
F Development	Sun Valley Park Development: Partner with SV Eco-District to create a new riverfront park including walking paths and landscaping
G Development	Barnum Park and Recreation Center: Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete, replace the basketball courts, and address recreation center deferred maintenance
H Development	Westwood Recreation Center: Construct a new recreation center
I Development	Castro Building: Address deferred maintenance
J Development	Fire Station 20: Refurbish kitchen space
K Development	Colfax Corridor Improvements: Improve pedestrian and bicycle safety
L Development	West Colfax Transit Enhancements: Improve transit efficiency
M Development	Colfax Bus Rapid Transit (BRT): Add exclusive bus lanes, new transit stops, and other improvements to allow the BRT to operate efficiently and effectively
N Design	West 13th Avenue Multimodal Reconstruction: Improvements along W. 13th Avenue, Holden Place, and Bryant Street to improve access between downtown and western neighborhoods for pedestrians, bicyclists, transit, and vehicles
O Design	8th Avenue Bridge over South Platte River: Reconstruction of the bridge over South Platte River
P Development	8th Avenue Bridge over the Railroad: Rehabilitate the bridge
Q Development	Morrison Road Improvements: Full reconstruction of the 1.5 mile stretch of Morrison Road to implement the community-prepared vision
See Legend	Citywide projects: Street paving, curb and gutter replacement, new sidewalks, new neighborhood bikeways, new protected bike lanes, and ADA projects
