<b>B</b> Development Complete	<b>Washington Park:</b> Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete, replace picnic areas <b>Washington Recreation Center:</b> Address kitchen and floor upgrades
<b>C</b> Development	<b>Potenza Neighborhood Park:</b> Replace aging playground equipment
<b>D</b> Development	<b>Cook Park and Recreation Center:</b> Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete and address recreation center deferred maintenance
<b>E</b> Development	<b>Harvard Gulch Recreation Center:</b> Upgrade facilities
<b>F</b> Design	<b>McWilliams Neighborhood Park:</b> Reconstruct existing basketball courts, playground equipment, and picnic areas
<b>G</b> Development	<b>Fire Station 21:</b> Refurbish kitchen space
<b>H</b> Development	<b>South Cherry Creek Transfer Station:</b> Address deferred maintenance
<b>I</b> Development	<b>Buchtel and Colorado Boulevard Intersection and Colorado Station Bike/Pedestrian Access Improvements:</b> Reconstruct intersection and add protected bike lanes and pedestrian safety features
<b>J</b> Development	<b>Monaco Parkway Bridge Over Cherry Creek:</b> Replace the bridge
