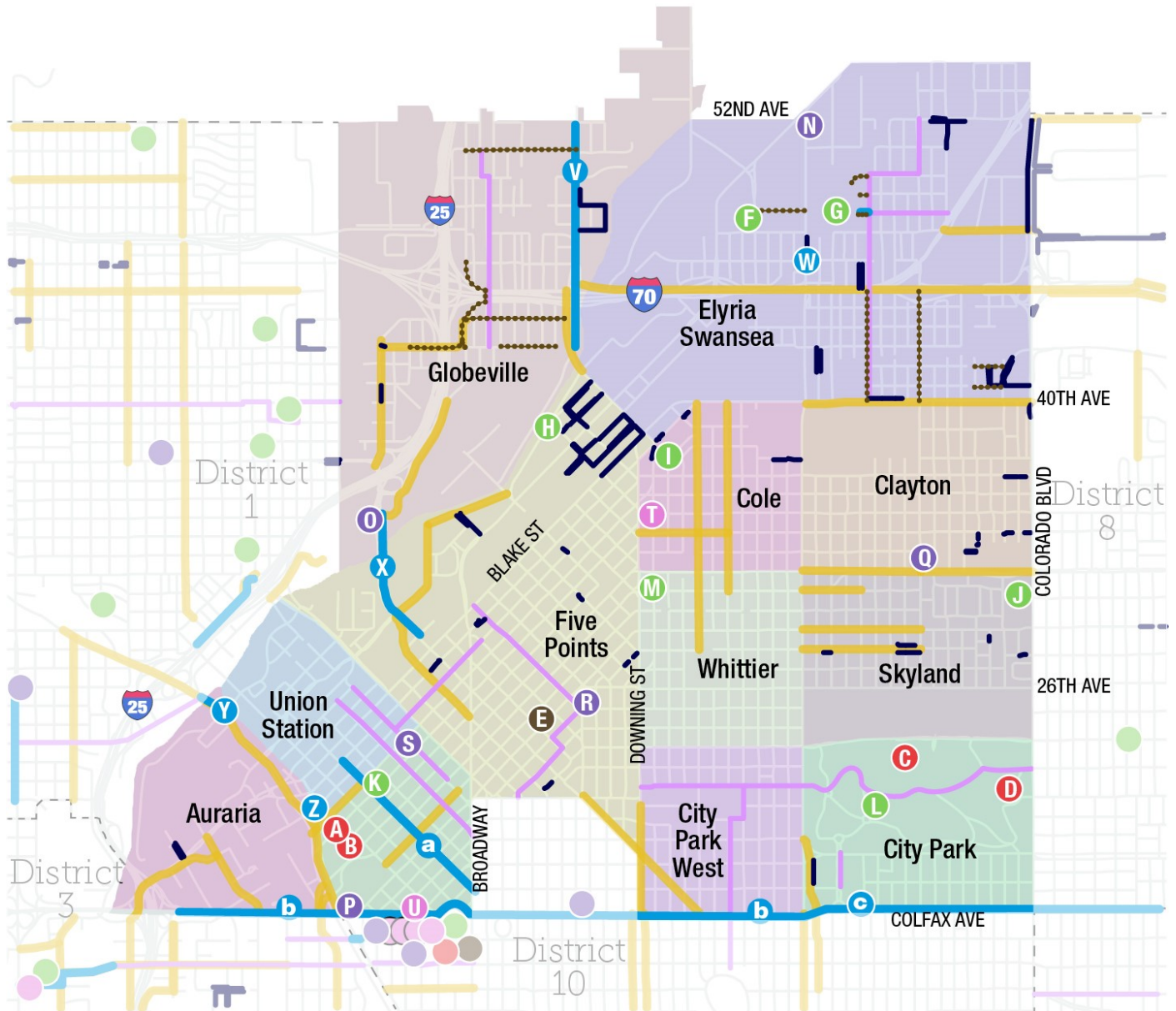

<b>A</b>	<i>Construction</i> <b>Bonfils Theater Complex:</b> Renovate the Stage Theater and office/administrative areas
<b>B</b>	<i>Design</i> <b>Buell Theater:</b> Renovate the lobby and restrooms, improve ADA access, and other improvements
<b>C</b>	<i>Construction</i> <b>Denver Zoo:</b> Build new animal hospital and purchase equipment
<b>D</b>	<i>Construction</i> <b>Denver Museum of Nature and Science:</b> Address deferred maintenance
<b>E</b>	<i>Design</i> <b>Blair-Caldwell Library:</b> Replace outdated equipment, renovate space, restore and enhance landscaping, sidewalks, and parking lots
<b>F</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Elyria Neighborhood Park:</b> Reconstruct existing basketball courts
<b>G</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Swansea Recreation Center:</b> Construct new indoor swimming pool
<b>H</b>	<i>Design</i> <b>Arkins Court Promenade:</b> Create a new riverfront pedestrian promenade
<b>I</b>	<i>Design</i> <b>St. Charles Recreation Center:</b> Address recreation center deferred maintenance
<b>J</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Boyd Neighborhood Park:</b> Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete
<b>K</b>	<i>Design</i> <b>Skyline Park:</b> Redesign and improve park amenities and program areas
<b>L</b>	<i>Design</i> <b>City Park:</b> Update and replace aging playground equipment at Dustin Redd Playground
<b>M</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Dr. Daniel Hale Williams Park:</b> Upgrade playground
<b>N</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Denver Sheriff Department Impound Lot:</b> Address deferred maintenance for the administrative building
<b>O</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Denver Police Firing Range:</b> Address deferred maintenance
<b>P</b>	<i>Construction</i> <b>Fire Station 1:</b> Retrofit restrooms to be gender equitable
<b>Q</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Fire Station 10:</b> Refurbish kitchen space
<b>R</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Fire Station 3:</b> Refurbish kitchen space
<b>S</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Fire Station 4:</b> Refurbish kitchen space
<b>T</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>North East Montessori Center:</b> Address deferred maintenance
<b>U</b>	<i>Design</i> <b>Minoru Yasui Building:</b> Address deferred maintenance
<b>V</b>	<i>Design</i> <b>Washington Street:</b> Reconstruct the road to improve traffic flow, pedestrian access and safety
See Legend	<i>Development/Design</i> <b>Globeville-Elyria-Swansea Pedestrian Connections:</b> Implement bicycle and pedestrian safety and connectivity improvements
<b>W</b>	<i>Construction</i> <b>47th &amp; York Bicycle and Pedestrian Bridge:</b> Construct a bicycle and pedestrian bridge over the railroad to improve safety and neighborhood connectivity
<b>X</b>	<i>Phase I Construction</i> <i>Phase II Design</i> <b>Park Avenue Bridge:</b> Rehabilitate the bridge
<b>Y</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Speer Boulevard Bridge Over Little Raven Street:</b> Rehabilitate the bridge
<b>Z</b>	<i>Design</i> <b>Connecting Auraria:</b> Reconstruct the Larimer Street bridge over Cherry Creek to improve safety and multimodal connectivity to the Auraria campus
<b>a</b>	<i>Design</i> <b>16th Street Mall:</b> Reconstruct the mall to improve sidewalks, transit way, and streetscaping
<b>b</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Colfax Bus Rapid Transit (BRT):</b> Add exclusive bus lanes, new transit stops, and other improvements to allow the BRT to operate efficiently and effectively
<b>c</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Colfax Corridor Improvements:</b> Improve pedestrian and bicycle safety
