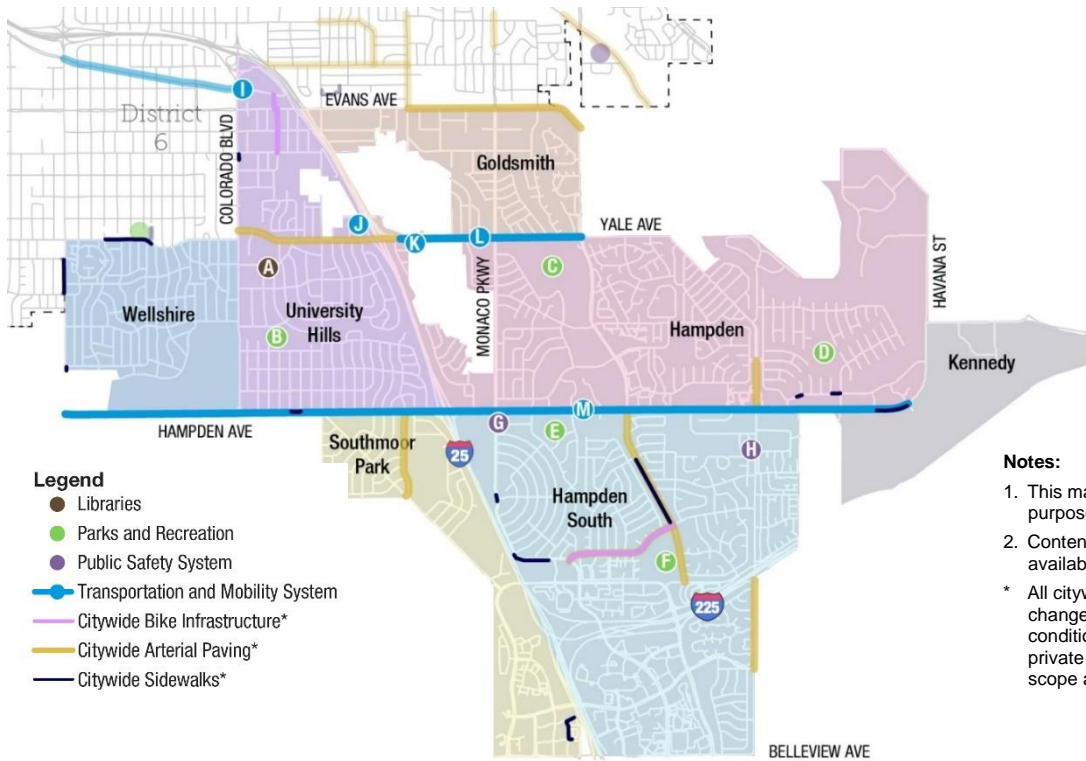


# ELEVATE DENVER BOND PROGRAM COUNCIL DISTRICT 4 PROJECTS

Current Status	Project Name and Description
<b>A</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Ross-University Hill Library:</b> Replace outdated equipment and renovate space
<b>B</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Eisenhower Neighborhood Park and Recreation Center:</b> Replace picnic areas, provide upgrades, and address recreation center deferred maintenance
<b>C</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Bible Park:</b> Replace aging playground equipment and improve walkways
<b>D</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Hampden Heights Neighborhood Park:</b> Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete
<b>E</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Southmoor Neighborhood Park:</b> Upgrade asphalt paths and replace basketball courts
<b>F</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Rosamond Neighborhood Park:</b> Replace outdated playground equipment and basketball courts
<b>G</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Fire Station 22:</b> Retrofit restrooms to be gender equitable
<b>H</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Fire Station 13:</b> Refurbish kitchen space
<b>I</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Buchtel and Colorado Boulevard Intersection and Colorado Station Bike/Pedestrian Access Improvements:</b> Reconstruct intersection and add protected bike lanes and pedestrian safety features
<b>J</b>	<i>Design</i> <b>Yale Station Pedestrian Safety:</b> Improve pedestrian safety features and enhance access to public transit
<b>K</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>High Line Canal:</b> Construct new underpass for High Line Canal Trail at Yale Avenue
<b>L</b>	<i>Development</i> <b>Yale Avenue Improvements:</b> Improve traffic signal operations, sidewalks, and bicycle lanes
<b>M</b>	<i>Design</i> <b>Hampden Corridor Multimodal Improvements:</b> General improvements to enhance traffic flow, including additional safety features and access to public transit
