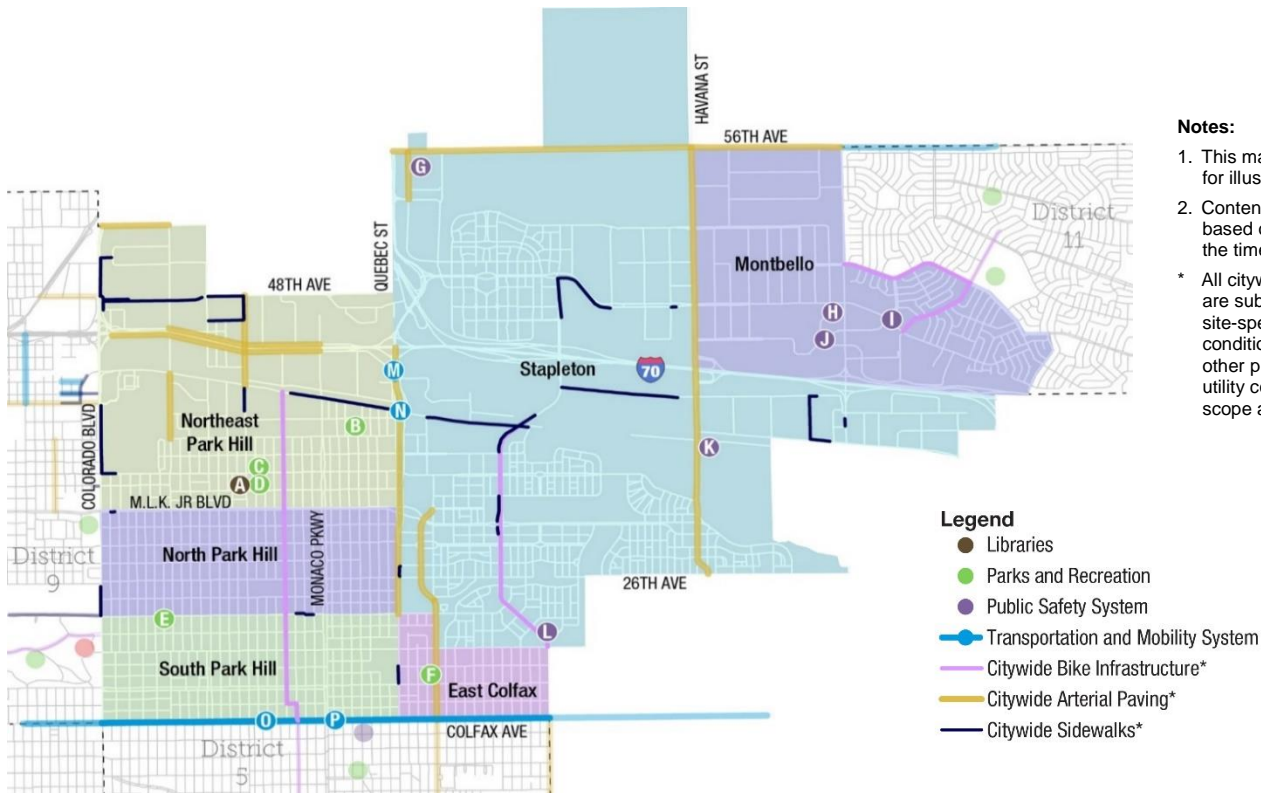


ELEVATE DENVER BOND PROGRAM COUNCIL DISTRICT 8 PROJECTS

G Development	Roslyn Complex Upgrades: Replace outdated equipment and renovate

K Design	Denver County Jail: Upgrade fire sprinkler system
